

Simplex Test Controller - instructions for test S2-25

This is (Call sign here) and my name is (first name here). I will be acting test control for Alachua Simplex test S2-25. This test will be conducted using the 146.820 repeater and the simplex frequency 146.550. You will need to monitor both the 146.820 repeater and the 146.550 simplex frequency. This can be done by switching between frequencies or using two radios.

Please do not transmit until requested. I will be using the Alachua County Simplex Test Data Form to call out transmitting stations in the order given. Please make sure your call sign and name are on the form. Make sure your handwriting is clearly legible so your information can be properly entered on the Master Simplex Sheet.

(Break)

When requested, transmit on 146.550 and say the following two times slowly:

This is (first name) then (call sign phonetically) operating on Simplex frequency 146.550.

After saying it two times then say:

I am now returning to net control on 146.820.

All those who are listening please use the Alachua County Simplex Test Data Form. If you do not have a Data Form, record the call sign and readability of the signal on all stations that you have heard. Monitor the repeater to determine who will be transmitting next.

(Break)

I will now begin the simplex test. This is simplex test control. Request station (insert 1st station here) begin transmitting

After last transmitting station from list is complete and time permits read the following;

If anyone else would like to transmit then contact the test controller via the repeater. Volunteers will also transmit on 146.550 simplex.

When your transmission is complete remember to contact the test controller via the repeater.

Volunteer transmitters please call now giving your name and call sign.

After last transmission is complete

This concludes Alachua Simplex test (S4-24).
